- 4 Government Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 5 (a) The state prosecuting attorney or a [A] state prosecutor
- 6 may not engage in the private practice of law but may complete all
- 7 civil cases that are not in conflict with the interest of any of the
- 8 counties of the district in which the <u>attorney or</u> prosecutor serves
- 9 and that are pending in court before the <u>attorney or</u> prosecutor
- 10 takes office.
- 11 (b) The state prosecuting attorney or a [A] state prosecutor
- 12 may not accept a fee from an attorney to whom the state prosecuting
- 13 <u>attorney or state</u> prosecutor has referred a case.
