1-8 relating to reimbursement of members of the Guardianship
1-9 Certification Board for certain expenses.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Subsection (g), Section 111.011, Government
1-12 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-13 (g) The members of the board serve for staggered six-year
1-14 terms, with the terms of one-third of the members expiring on
1-15 February 1 of each odd-numbered year. Board members serve without
1-16 [are not entitled to receive] compensation but are entitled to [or]
1-17 reimbursement for travel expenses and other actual and necessary
1-18 expenses incurred in the performance of official board duties, as
1-19 provided by the General Appropriations Act.

1-20 SECTION 2. Subsection (b), Section 111.012, Government
1-21 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-22 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, the Office of Court
1-23 Administration shall:

1-24 (1) provide administrative assistance, services, and
1-25 materials to the board, including budget planning and purchasing;

1-26 (2) accept, deposit, and disburse money made available
1-27 to the board;

1-28 (3) pay the salaries and benefits of the director;

1-29 (4) reimburse the travel expenses and other actual and
1-30 necessary expenses of the director incurred in the performance of a
1-31 function of the board, as provided by the General Appropriations
1-32 Act; ~~and~~

1-33 (5) reimburse the travel expenses and other actual and
1-34 necessary expenses of board members incurred in the performance of
1-35 official board duties, as provided by the General Appropriations
1-36 Act; and

1-37 (6) provide the board with adequate computer equipment
1-38 and support.

1-39 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
