5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 552, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 552.1176 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 552.1176. CONFIDENTIALITY OF CERTAIN INFORMATION OF
8	PERSON LICENSED TO PRACTICE LAW. (a) Information that relates to
9	the home address, home telephone number, electronic mail address,
10	social security number, or date of birth of a person licensed to
11	practice law in this state is confidential and may not be disclosed
12	to the public under this chapter if the person to whom the
13	<pre>information relates:</pre>
14	(1) chooses to restrict public access to the
15	information; and
16	(2) notifies the governmental body of the person's
17	choice, in writing or electronically, on a form provided by the
18	governmental body.
19	(b) A choice made under Subsection (a) remains valid until

documents filed with a district clerk are exempt from this section.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.

(c) All documents filed with a county clerk and all

rescinded in writing or electronically by the person.
