- 5 SECTION 1. Section 21.0111(a), Property Code, is amended to

- A governmental entity with eminent domain authority 7
- that wants to acquire real property for a public use: 8
- (1) shall disclose to the property owner at the time an 9
- offer to purchase is made any and all existing appraisal reports 10
- produced or acquired by the governmental entity relating 11
- 12 specifically to the owner's property and used in determining the
- 13 final valuation offer;
- 14 (2) shall inform the property owner at the time an
- offer to purchase is made that the property owner may seek legal 15
- 16 counsel;
- (3) shall provide to the property owner at the time an 17
- 18 offer to purchase is made an estimate of the costs of legal
- services; and 19
- (4) may not advise the property owner that the 20
- 21 property owner does not need to seek legal counsel.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 23
- provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. 24
