- 6 SECTION 1. Section 1051.356, Occupations Code, is amended 7 by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows: 8
- The continuing education programs: 9
- (1) must include courses relating to sustainable or 10 energy-efficient design standards; and 11
- 12 (2) may include courses relating to:
- 13 (A) (A) health, safety, or welfare; or
- 14 (B) $[\frac{(2)}{2}]$ barrier-free design.
- 15 (b-1) As part of a certificate holder's continuing education requirements for each annual registration period, the 16 board by rule shall require the certificate holder to complete at 17 least one hour of continuing education relating to sustainable or 18 19 energy-efficient design standards.
- SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 20 an application for the renewal of a certificate of registration 21 22 that is filed with the Texas Board of Architectural Examiners on or 23 after September 1, 2008. An application for the renewal of a certificate of registration filed before September 1, 2008, is 24

- 1 governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date
- 2 of this Act, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 3 purpose.
- 4 SECTION 3. Not later than January 1, 2008, the Texas Board
- of Architectural Examiners shall adopt rules, procedures, forms,
- 6 and fees under Section 1051.356, Occupations Code, as amended by
- 7 this Act.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
