## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2	relating to authorized activities for the holder of a distiller's
3	and rectifier's permit.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 14.01(a), Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(a) The holder of a distiller's and rectifier's permit may:
8	(1) manufacture distilled spirits;
9	(2) rectify, purify, and refine distilled spirits and
10	wines;
11	(3) mix wines, distilled spirits, or other liquors;
12	(4) bottle, label, and package his finished products;
13	(5) sell the finished products in this state to
14	holders of wholesaler's permits and to qualified persons outside
15	the state; [and]
16	(6) import distilled spirits, to be used only for
17	manufacturing or rectification purposes, from holders of
18	nonresident seller's permits <u>;</u>
19	(7) sell distilled spirits to ultimate consumers in
20	unbroken packages for off-premises consumption in an amount not to
21	exceed 1,057 gallons annually of each different type of distilled
22	spirits manufactured by the permit holder; and
23	(8) dispense free distilled spirits for consumption on
24	the permitted premises.
