1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the enforcement of commercial motor vehicle safety
1-9 standards by certain peace officers.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 644.101, Transportation
1-12 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-13 (b) A police officer of any of the following municipalities
1-14 is eligible to apply for certification under this section:

1-15 (1) a municipality with a population of 50,000
1-16 [~~100,000~~] or more;

1-17 (2) a municipality with a population of 25,000 or more
1-18 any part of which is located in a county with a population of
1-19 500,000 [~~two million~~] or more;

1-20 (3) a municipality with a population of less than
1-21 25,000:

1-22 (A) any part of which is located in a county with
1-23 a population of 2.4 million; and

1-24 (B) that contains or is adjacent to an
1-25 international port; or

1-26 (4) a municipality any part of which is located in a
1-27 county bordering the United Mexican States.

1-28 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
