1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to designating April as Texas Fruit and Vegetable Month.

1-9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-10 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 662, Government Code, is  
1-11 amended by adding Section 662.103 to read as follows:

1-12 Sec. 662.103. TEXAS FRUIT AND VEGETABLE MONTH. (a) April  
1-13 is Texas Fruit and Vegetable Month to promote awareness of the  
1-14 health benefits of fruits and vegetables and to encourage Texans to  
1-15 consume more fruits and vegetables.

1-16 (b) Texas Fruit and Vegetable Month shall be regularly  
1-17 observed by appropriate celebrations and activities.

1-18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-22 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
