## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to staff development requirements in public schools.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 21.451, Education Code, is amended by
5	amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsections (e) and (f) to read
6	as follows:
7	(d) The staff development [may]:
8	(1) may include training in:
9	(A) technology;
10	(B) conflict resolution; and
11	(C) discipline strategies, including classroom
12	management, district discipline policies, and the student code of
13	conduct adopted under Section 37.001 and Chapter 37; and
14	(2) <u>must</u> include <u>research-based</u> training that:
15	(A) relates to instruction of students with
16	disabilities; and
17	(B) is designed for educators who work primarily
18	outside the area of special education.
19	(e) In developing the training required by Subsection
20	(d)(2), a school district must consult with persons with expertise
21	in research-based practices for students with disabilities.
22	Persons who may be consulted under this subsection include
23	colleges, universities, private and nonprofit organizations,

- 4 (f) The staff development may[; and
- $[\frac{(3)}{(3)}]$  include instruction as to what is permissible
- 6 under law, including opinions of the United States Supreme Court,
- 7 regarding prayer in public school.
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2007-2008
- 9 school year.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
