- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 42, Penal Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Section 42.14 to read as follows:
- Sec. 42.14. ILLUMINATION OF AIRCRAFT BY INTENSE LIGHT. (a)
- 8 A person commits an offense if:
- 9 <u>(1) the person intentionally directs a light from a</u>
- 10 laser pointer or other light source at an aircraft; and
- 11 (2) the light has an intensity sufficient to impair
- 12 the operator's ability to control the aircraft.
- 13 (b) It is an affirmative defense to prosecution under this
- 14 section that the actor was using the light to send an emergency
- 15 distress signal.

- 16 (c) An offense under this section is a Class C misdemeanor
- 17 unless the intensity of the light impairs the operator's ability to
- 18 control the aircraft, in which event the offense is a Class A
- 19 misdemeanor.
- 20 (d) If conduct that constitutes an offense under this
- 21 section also constitutes an offense under any other law, the actor
- 22 may be prosecuted under this section or the other law.
- (e) In this section, "laser pointer" has the meaning
- 24 assigned by Section 42.13.
