1-7 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-8 AN ACT

1-9 relating to the marking of oyster beds.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 76.036, Parks and
1-12 Wildlife Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-13 (a) The holder of a permit shall clearly and distinctly mark
1-14 by buoys or other permanent markers easily visible above the
1-15 surface of the water the boundaries of the areas designated in the
1-16 permit from which he may take or in which he may deposit oysters.

1-17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-21 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
