5	SECTION 1. Section 31.107, Parks and Wildlife Code, is

7	Sec. 31.107. OPERATION OF MOTORBOAT. No person may operate
8	a motorboat of over $\underline{10}$ [$\overline{15}$] horsepower on the public waters of this
9	state unless the person has successfully completed a boater
10	education course as required by Section 31.109 and:
11	(1) is 16 years of age or older; or [÷]
12	(2) [(1)] is at least 13 years of age and is
13	accompanied by a person (18) years of age or older who has
14	successfully completed a boater education course as required by
15	<u>Section 31.109</u> [+ or
16	[(2) is at least 13 years of age and has successfully
17	passed a boating safety course prescribed and approved by the
18	department].
19	SECTION 2. Section 31.109(a), Parks and Wildlife Code, is
20	amended to read as follows:

(1) [(A)] a vessel powered by a motor of 10 horsepower

- 5 SECTION 3. Section 31.110, Parks and Wildlife Code, is

- 7 Sec. 31.110. EXEMPTION FROM BOATER EDUCATION COURSE
- 8 REQUIREMENT. A person is not required to comply with Section 31.109
- 9 if the person:
- 10 (1) holds a master's, mate's, or operator's license
- 11 issued by the United States Coast Guard; or
- 12 (2) [is supervised by a person who:

- 14 Section 31.109 or possesses a boater identification card as

- Sec. 31.112. FEES. (a) Any fees collected by the
