5	SECTION 1. Subchapter I, Chapter 21, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 21.416 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 21.416. TEACHER INFORMATION POSTED ON AGENCY WEBSITE.
8	The agency shall post on the agency's Internet website information
9	relevant to the teaching profession, including information
10	regarding:
11	(1) educator certification, including alternative
12	<pre>certification information;</pre>
13	(2) school district job vacancies, organized by
14	subject, grade level, and geographic area;
15	(3) salary schedules for each school district,
16	organized by position and years of experience;
17	(4) the teacher appraisal process;
18	(5) continuing education requirements and
19	opportunities;
20	(6) the Teacher Retirement System of Texas, including
21	<pre>information relating to:</pre>
22	(A) retirement benefits;
23	(B) health insurance for active employees; and
24	(C) health insurance for retirees;

1	(7) lesson plan ideas organized by grade level and
2	subject area;
3	(8) Texas universities and colleges that offer
4	advanced education degrees and financial assistance programs;
5	(9) instructional resources available through the
6	regional education service centers; and

8	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
