3	duties of the Hays Trinity Groundwater Conservation District.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 966, Acts of the 77th Legislature,
6	Regular Session, 2001, is amended by adding Sections 3.03052 and
7	3.03055 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 3.03052. CONTRACTS. The district may enter into
9	contracts in the manner provided by Section 36.067, Water Code.
10	Sec. 3.03055. COLLECTION OF INFORMATION. The district shall
11	collect information as permitted under Section 36.109, Water Code,
12	to assist in joint planning efforts in the management area of the
13	district under Section 36.108, Water Code.
14	SECTION 2. Section 3.0306(a), Chapter 966, Acts of the 77th
15	Legislature, Regular Session, 2001, is amended to read as follows:
16	(a) The district annually shall prepare a budget and conduct

(a) The district annually shall prepare a budget and conduct an audit in accordance with Subchapter E, Chapter 36, Water Code [showing proposed expenditures and disbursements and estimated receipts and collections for the next fiscal year and shall hold a public hearing on the proposed budget. The district must publish notice of the hearing at least once in a newspaper of general circulation in the county not later than the 10th day before the date of the hearing. A taxpayer of the district is entitled to appear at the hearing to be heard regarding any item in the proposed

- 2 SECTION 3. Sections 3.0307(d) and (g), Chapter 966, Acts of
- 3 the 77th Legislature, Regular Session, 2001, are amended to read as
- 4 follows:
- 5 (d) Permanent directors serve staggered <u>four-year</u>
- 6 [two-year] terms.
- 7 (g) If there is a vacancy on the board, <u>it shall be filled in</u>
- 8 <u>accordance with Chapter 36.051, Water Code</u> [the Hays County
- 9 Commissioners Court shall appoint a director to serve the remainder
- 10 of the term].
- SECTION 4. Section 3.0308(d), Chapter 966, Acts of the 77th
- 12 Legislature, Regular Session, 2001, is amended to read as follows:
- 13 (d) The board of [initial or permanent] directors may revise
- 14 the <u>single-member</u> districts as necessary or appropriate. The board
- of directors shall revise each single-member district after each
- 16 federal decennial census to reflect population changes. When the
- 17 boundaries of the single-member districts are changed, a director
- 18 in office on the effective date of the change, or elected or
- 19 appointed before the effective date of the change to a term of
- 20 office beginning on or after the effective date of the change, is
- 21 <u>entitled to serve the term or remainder of the term in the</u>
- 22 <u>single-member district to which elected or appointed even though</u>
- 23 the change in boundaries places the person's residence outside the
- $\underline{\text{single-member district for which the person was elected or}}$
- 25 appointed. [At the first election after the single-member
- 26 districts are revised, a new director shall be elected from each
- 27 district. The directors shall draw lots to determine which two

- 1 directors serve one-year terms and which three directors serve
- 2 two-year terms.
- 3 SECTION 5. Chapter 966, Acts of the 77th Legislature,
- 4 Regular Session, 2001, is amended by amending Section 3.0310 and
- 5 adding Section 3.03105 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 3.0310. ELECTION OF DIRECTORS. $[\frac{a}{a}]$ On the <u>uniform</u>
- 7 <u>election date prescribed by Section 41.001, Election Code, [first</u>
- 8 Saturday in May [or the first Tuesday after the first Monday in
- 9 November] of each [the first] even-numbered year [after the year in
- 10 which the district is authorized to be created at a confirmation
- 11 election, an election shall be held in the district for the election
- 12 of three directors to serve two-year terms and two directors to
- 13 serve one-year terms.
- 14 [(b) On the first Saturday in May or the first Tuesday after
- 15 the first Monday in November, as applicable, of each subsequent
- 16 second year following the election held under Subsection (a) of
- 17 this section], the appropriate number of directors shall be
- 18 elected.
- 19 Sec. 3.03105. ELECTION OF DIRECTORS IN 2009. On the uniform
- 20 election date prescribed by Section 41.001, Election Code, in May
- 21 2009, an election shall be held in the district for the election of
- 22 the directors from single-member districts 2 and 4 to serve
- 23 <u>one-year terms.</u>
- SECTION 6. Chapter 966, Acts of the 77th Legislature,
- 25 Regular Session, 2001, is amended by adding Section 3.03125 to read
- 26 as follows:
- Sec. 3.03125. USE OF FEES. The district may use fees

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- 1 collected under Section 3.0312 of this part to pay the
- 2 administrative and other expenses of the district.
- 3 SECTION 7. Sections 3.0304(d) and 3.0306(b), Chapter 966,
- 4 Acts of the 77th Legislature, Regular Session, 2001, are repealed.
- 5 SECTION 8. The Hays Trinity Groundwater Conservation
- 6 District directors elected from single-member districts 2 and 4 on
- 7 the uniform election date prescribed by Section 41.001, Election
- 8 Code, in May 2007 serve the two-year terms to which they were
- 9 elected.
- 10 SECTION 9. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
