## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to allowing a student receiving special education services
- 3 to participate in a graduation ceremony after the fourth year of
- 4 high school.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 28.025, Education Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:
- 8 <u>(f) A school district shall issue a certificate of</u>
- 9 attendance to a student who receives special education services
- 10 under Subchapter A, Chapter 29, and who has completed four years of
- 11 high school but has not completed the student's individualized
- 12 education program. A school district shall allow a student who
- 13 receives a certificate to participate in a graduation ceremony with
- 14 students receiving high school diplomas. A student may participate
- 15 in only one graduation ceremony under this subsection. This
- 16 <u>subsection does not preclude a student</u> from receiving a diploma
- 17 under Subsection (c)(2).
- 18 SECTION 2. Subsection (f), Section 28.025, Education Code,
- 19 as added by this Act, applies beginning with the 2006-2007 school
- 20 year.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
