(A) pay any debts incurred; 1 2 (B) transfer to Waller County any assets that 3 remain after the payment of debts; and (C) maintain the organization of the district 4 until all debts are paid and remaining assets are transferred; and 5 (2) this chapter expires September 1, 2014. 6 7 Sec. 8205.004. INITIAL DISTRICT TERRITORY. (a) The district is initially composed of the territory described by 8 Section 2 of the Act creating this chapter. 9 10 (b) The boundaries and field notes contained in Section 2 of the Act creating this chapter form a closure. A mistake made in the 11 field notes or in copying the field notes in the legislative process 12 13 does not affect: 14 (1) the organization, existence, or validity of the 15 district; 16 (2) the right of the district to impose taxes; 17 (3) the validity of the district's bonds, notes, or 18 indebtedness; or 19 (4) the legality or operation of the district or the 20 board. Sec. 8205.005. EFFECT OF CHAPTER ON BROOKSHIRE-KATY 21 DRAINAGE DISTRICT OF WALLER COUNTY. 12	expires September 1, 2014.

9	(c) The district may not undertake a road project unless

13	be divided into two new districts only if the district:
14	(1) has no outstanding bonded debt; and

Bennett Survey, Abstract 288, and the north line of said adjoining Tracts 73, 74, 75, and 76 (Sport Flyer's 8 Estates Subdivision), at 834.14 feet pass a <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> inch iron pipe found 9 10 on said line for the northwest corner of said adjoining Tract 76 (Sport Flyer's Estates Subdivision), same being the northeast 11 corner of an adjoining called 22.00 acre tract described in deed 12 recorded in Volume 0543, Page 906, Official Records, Waller County, 13 Texas, at 1,881.55 feet pass a  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch iron pipe with cap marked 14 15 "Kalkomey Surveying" found on said line for the northwest corner of 16 said adjoining called 22.00 acre tract, same being the northeast corner of the aforementioned adjoining called 20.00 acre tract 17 18 described in deed recorded in Volume 0540, Page 687, Official Records, Waller County, Texas, and continuing for a total distance 19 of 3,371.67 feet (called 3,371.54 feet) to the Place of Beginning 20 and containing 1,445.765 acres of land, more or less. 21

22 SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to 23 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this 24 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a 25 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies, 26 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished 27 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,

1 Government Code.

2 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has 3 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on 4 Environmental Quality.

5 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed 6 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the 7 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of 8 representatives within the required time.

9 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this 10 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect 11 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled 12 and accomplished.

SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
