5	SECTION 1. Section 2054.1115(a), Government Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(a) A state agency or local government that uses TexasOnline
8	may use electronic payment methods, including the acceptance of
9	credit and debit cards, for <u>:</u>
LO	(1) point-of-sale <u>transactions</u> , <u>including</u> :
L1	(A) person-to-person transactions;
L2	(B) transactions that use an automated process to
L3	facilitate a person-to-person transaction; and
L4	(C) transactions completed by a person at an
L5	unattended self-standing computer station using an automated
L6	process;
L7	(2) telephone <u>transactions</u> ; $[\tau]$ or
L8	(3) mail transactions.
L9	SECTION 2. Section 2054.252, Government Code, is amended by
20	adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
21	(b-1) The department may include in the electronic
22	infrastructure established under Subsection (a) a method by which
23	a state agency or local government may track payments, including

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cash and credit card payments, received by the state agency or local

- 1 government, whether or not the payments are made through the
- 2 <u>infrastructure</u>.
- 3 SECTION 3. Section 2054.261, Government Code, is amended to
- 4 read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 2054.261. ASSISTANCE AND COORDINATION WITH OTHER
- 6 GOVERNMENTAL ENTITIES. (a) The department shall:
- 7 (1) assist state agencies and local governments in
- 8 researching and identifying potential funding sources for the
- 9 project;
- 10 (2) assist state agencies and local governments in
- 11 using the project;
- 12 (3) assist the legislature and other state leadership
- in coordinating electronic government initiatives; and
- 14 (4) coordinate operations between state agencies and
- 15 local governments to achieve integrated planning for the project.
- 16 (b) The department by rule shall adopt standards for state
- 17 agency Internet websites to ensure consistency and compatibility
- 18 with the project. Each state agency shall make its Internet website
- 19 conform to the standards.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
