| 4  | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:                              |
| 5  | SECTION 1. Subdivision (8), Section 402.044, Local                                   |
| 6  | Government Code, is amended to read as follows:                                      |
| 7  | (8) "Service area" means the municipal boundaries and                                |
| 8  | any other land areas outside the municipal boundaries which, as a                    |
| 9  | result of topography or hydraulics, contribute overland flow into                    |
| 10 | the watersheds served by the drainage system of a municipality;                      |
| 11 | provided, however, that in no event may a service area extend                        |
| 12 | farther than the boundaries of a municipality's current                              |
| 13 | extraterritorial jurisdiction, nor, except as provided by Section                    |
| 14 | 402.0451, may a service area of one municipality extend into the                     |
| 15 | boundaries of another municipality. The service area is to be                        |
| 16 | established in the ordinance establishing the drainage utility.                      |
| 17 | Provided, that no municipality shall extend a service area outside                   |
| 18 | of its municipal boundaries except:  |
| 19 | (A) a municipality of more than <u>500,000</u> [400,000]                             |
| 20 | population located <u>within 50 miles of an international border</u> [ <del>in</del> |
| 21 | one or more counties of less than 600,000 population according to                    |
| 22 | the most recent federal census];   |
| 23 | (B) a municipality all or part of which is   |
| 24 | located over or within the Edwards Aquifer recharge zone or the                      |

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Edwards Aquifer transition zone, as designated by the Texas Natural 1 2 Resource Conservation Commission; or 3 (C) as provided by Section 402.0451. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 4 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 6 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2007. 8
