- 2 relating to the authority of a dental assistant to perform coronal

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 258.002, Occupations
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) A licensed dentist may delegate, under Subsection (a),
- 8 the performance of a coronal polishing and application of a pit and
- 9 fissure sealant to a dental assistant <u>certified under Section</u>
- 10 265.004 [if the dentist is a Medicaid provider or the dentist
- 11 practices in an area determined to be underserved by the Texas
- 12 Department of Health]. Cleansing of the occlusal and smooth
- 13 surfaces of the teeth by a dental assistant is allowed immediately
- 14 prior to and for the sole purpose of preparing the tooth area for
- 15 the placement of pit and fissure sealants or orthodontic bonding
- 16 resin, and shall not be billed as a prophylaxis.
- 17 SECTION 2. Section 265.003, Occupations Code, is amended to
- 18 read as follows:
- 19 Sec. 265.003. PERMITTED DUTIES. (a) A dental assistant
- 20 who is not professionally licensed may:
- 21 (1) be employed by and work in the office of a licensed
- 22 and practicing dentist; and
- 23 (2) perform one or more delegated dental acts under
- 24 the direct supervision, direction, and responsibility of the

- 1 dentist, including the performance of a coronal polishing and
- 2 application of a pit and fissure sealant.
- 3 (b) A dental assistant may perform a coronal polishing and
- 4 apply a pit and fissure sealant under Subsection (a) only if [+
- 5 [\(\frac{(1)}{1}\)] the assistant is certified to perform a coronal
- 6 polishing and apply a pit and fissure sealant under Section
- 7 265.004[<del>; and</del>
- 8 [(2) the dentist described by Subsection (a):
- 9 [(A) is a Medicaid provider; or
- 10 [(B) practices in an area determined to be
- 11 underserved by the Texas Department of Health].
- 12 SECTION 3. The heading to Section 265.004, Occupations
- 13 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 265.004. <u>CORONAL POLISHING</u> AND PIT AND FISSURE SEALANT
- 15 CERTIFICATE.
- SECTION 4. Subsections (a) and (b), Section 265.004,
- Occupations Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 18 (a) The board shall issue a coronal polishing and pit and
- 19 fissure sealant certificate to a dental assistant who qualifies
- 20 under this section.
- 21 (b) To qualify for a certificate, an applicant must:
- 22 (1) have at least two years' experience as a dental
- 23 assistant; and
- 24 (2) have successfully completed a minimum of 12 [16]
- 25 hours of clinical and didactic education in coronal polishing and
- 26 pit and fissure sealants taken through an accredited dental hygiene
- 27 program or a dental assisting program accredited by the Commission

- 2 approved by the board.
- 3 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
