- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 28, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 28.0254 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 28.0254. HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA FOR CERTAIN CRIME
- 8 VICTIMS. (a) This section applies only to a school district with
- 9 an enrollment at the beginning of the school year of more than
- 10 80,000 students.

- 11 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of this code, on
- 12 request of the student's parent, a school district shall issue a
- 13 <u>high school diploma posthumously to each student who:</u>
- 14 (1) attended high school in the district during the
- 200<u>5-2006 school year at grade level 12; and</u>
- 16 (2) was the victim of criminal homicide during that
- 17 school year.
- 18 (c) This section expires September 1, 2008.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
