 21 Subsection (a)(2) or (3) [(a)] may be had upon the uncorroborated

- 1 with another dog to protect livestock, other property, or a person
- 2 from the other dog, and for no other purpose.
- 3 (e) An offense under [Subdivision (1) or (5) of] Subsection
- 4 (a)(4) or (5) $[\frac{(a)}{(a)}]$ is a Class A misdemeanor. An offense under
- 5 [Subdivision (2), (3), or (4) of] Subsection (a)(1), (2), or (3)
- 6 [(a)] is a state jail felony. [An offense under Subdivision (6) of
- 7 Subsection (a) is a Class C misdemeanor.
- 8 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 9 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 10 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 11 covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the
- 12 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of
- 13 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of
- 14 this Act if any element of the offense was committed before that
- 15 date.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
