## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the conversion of a two-way frontage road to a one-way
3	frontage road by the Texas Department of Transportation.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 203, Transportation Code,
6	is amended by adding Section 203.035 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 203.035. CONVERSION OF TWO-WAY FRONTAGE ROAD TO
8	ONE-WAY FRONTAGE ROAD. The department may convert a frontage road
9	that provides for two-way movement of traffic to a frontage road
10	that provides for one-way movement of traffic unless:
11	(1) there is no corresponding frontage road on the
12	opposite side of the main-traveled lanes of the controlled access
13	highway associated with the frontage road for the circulation of
14	<pre>local traffic; and</pre>
15	(2) before the conversion is completed, a motion or
16	order objecting to the conversion is adopted and filed with the
17	district engineer for the applicable department district by:
18	(A) the commissioners court of the county in
19	which the frontage road is located; or
20	(B) if the frontage road or the portion of the
21	frontage road being converted is wholly contained within the
22	incorporated limits of a city, the city council or governing body of
23	the city in which the frontage road or the portion of the frontage
24	road is located.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
