1-8 relating to the amount of hazardous duty pay for certain state

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Subsections (a) and (d), Section 659.305,
1-12 Government Code, are amended to read as follows:

1-13 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), the amount of a
1-14 full-time state employee's hazardous duty pay for a particular
1-15 month is ~~[the lesser of:~~

1-16 ~~[(1)]~~ \$10 for each 12-month period of lifetime service
1-17 credit accrued by the employee ~~[+ or~~

1-18 ~~[(2) — \$300]~~.

1-19 (d) For purposes of Subsections (a) ~~[(a)(1)]~~ and (b)(2),
1-20 the number of 12-month periods of lifetime service credit that the
1-21 employee has accrued must be determined as of the last day of the
1-22 preceding month.

1-23 SECTION 2. Subsection (c), Section 659.305, Government
1-24 Code, is repealed.

1-25 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
