## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. Subchapter L, Chapter 401, Health and Safety 4 Code, is amended by adding Section 401.4261 to read as follows: 5
- 6 Sec. 401.4261. SECURITY. (a) The department may require a
- person who holds a certification to provide security to assure 7
- performance of the person's obligations related to storing and 8
- 9 maintaining mammography records as required by this subchapter and
- department rule. 10
- (b) The department shall deposit the security to the credit 11 12 of the perpetual care account.
- 13 (c) The department by rule shall determine the amount and
- 14 type of security required under this section in accordance with
- reasonable estimates of the costs of storage and maintenance of 15
- 16 mammography records in a manner that protects the public health and
- safety. 17
- SECTION 2. Section 401.430(f), Health and Safety Code, is 18
- amended to read as follows: 19
- If, as a result of an inspection, the department 20
- 21 determines that a facility's mammography system fails to meet the
- 22 department's certification standards and the quality of
- mammography produced by that system creates a serious risk to 23
- public health, the department may require that [the failure is a 24

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- 1 Severity Level I violation under the department's rules, |
- 2 facility [shall] notify each patient affected [on whom the facility
- 3 performed a mammography during the 30 days preceding the date of the
- 4 inspection that revealed the failure]. The facility shall:
- 5  $\hspace{1cm}$  (1) inform the patient that the mammography system
- 6 failed to satisfy the department's certification standards;
- 7 (2) recommend that the patient <u>consult with the</u>
- 8 patient's physician regarding the need for another mammogram [have
- 9 another mammogram performed at a facility with a certified
- 10 mammography system]; and
- 11 (3) list the three facilities closest to the original
- 12 testing facility that have a certified mammography system.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
