5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

- 6 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 232.038, Local
- 8 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), a person who has
- 9 purchased or is purchasing a lot after July 1, 1995, in a
- 10 subdivision for residential purposes that does not have water and
- 11 sewer services as required by this subchapter and is located in an
- 12 economically distressed area, as defined by Section 17.921, Water
- 13 Code, from a subdivider, may bring suit in the district court in
- 14 which the property is located or in a district court in Travis
- 15 County to:
- 16 (1) declare the sale of the property void, [and]
- 17 require the subdivider to return the purchase price of the
- 18 property_,[+] and
- 19 $\left[\frac{(2)}{(2)}\right]$ recover from the subdivider:
- 20 (A) the market value of any permanent

13	Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
