4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 60, Water Code, is amended
6	by adding Section 60.080 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 60.080. PORT COMMISSION ACT OR PROCEEDING PRESUMED
8	VALID. (a) In this section, "district" means a navigation
9	district or port authority created under Section 52, Article III,
10	or Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, a local government
11	corporation or port development corporation of such a navigation
12	district or port authority, or any other public port authority.
13	(b) An act or proceeding of a district or its port
14	commission or board of directors or another governing body of the
15	district is conclusively presumed to be valid, as of the date it
16	occurred, and to have occurred in accordance with all applicable
17	statutes and ordinances if:

- 18 <u>(1) the second anniversary of the effective date of</u> 19 <u>the act or proceeding has expired; and</u>
- 20 (2) a lawsuit to annul or invalidate the act or 21 proceeding has not been filed on or before the second anniversary.
- 22 (c) This section does not apply to:
- 23 (1) an act or proceeding that was void at the time it occurred;

(2) an act or proceeding that, under a statute of this 1 2 state or the United States, was a misdemeanor or felony at the time 3 the act or proceeding occurred; or (3) a matter that on the effective date of this 4 5 section: (A) is involved in litigation if the litigation 6 7 ultimately results in the matter being held invalid by a final judgment of a court; or 8 (B) has been held invalid by a final judgment of a 9

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
