1 AN ACT 2 relating to the child fatality review process, including the 3 composition and functions of the child fatality review team 4 committee. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Subsections (a), (b), (c), (e), and (h), Section 7 264.502, Family Code, are amended to read as follows: The child fatality review team committee is composed of: 8 (a) (1) a person appointed by and representing the state 9 registrar [for the bureau] of vital statistics; 10 (2) a person appointed by and representing 11 commissioner [director of protective services for families and 12 13 children] of the department; 14 (3) a person appointed by and representing the Title V director of the [bureau of epidemiology of the Texas] Department of 15 State Health Services; and 16 individuals selected under Subsection (b). 17 The members of the committee who serve under Subsections 18 19 (a)(1) through (3) shall select the following additional committee members: 20 (1) a criminal prosecutor involved in prosecuting 21 22 crimes against children;

(2) a sheriff;

- 20 serve three-year [two-year] terms with the terms of five or six
- 21 <u>members, as appropriate, expiring</u> [that expire on] February 1 [of]
- 22 each [even-numbered] year.

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- (e) An appointment to a vacancy on the committee shall be
- 24 made in the same manner as the original appointment. A member is
- 25 <u>eligible for reappointment.</u>
- 26 (h) A member of the committee is not entitled to
- 27 compensation for serving on the committee but is entitled to

- 1 reimbursement for the member's travel expenses as provided in the
- 2 General Appropriations Act. Reimbursement under this subsection
- 3 for a person serving on the committee under Subsection (a)(2)
- 4 $\left[\frac{(a)(1) \text{ or } (3)}{(3)}\right]$ shall be paid from funds appropriated to the
- 5 department [Texas Department of Health]. Reimbursement for other
- 6 persons serving on the committee shall be paid from funds
- 7 appropriated to the <u>Department of State Health Services</u>
- 8 [department].
- 9 SECTION 2. Subsections (c), (d), and (f), Section 264.503,
- 10 Family Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 11 (c) The department shall work cooperatively with:
- 12 (1) the Department of State Health Services [recognize
- 13 the creation and participation of review teams]; [and]
- 14 (2) [work cooperatively with] the committee; and
- 15 (3) [with] individual child fatality review teams.
- 16 (d) The Department of State Health Services shall:
- 17 (1) recognize the creation and participation of review
- 18 teams;
- 19 (2) promote and coordinate training to assist the
- 20 review teams in carrying out their duties;
- (3) (3) [(2)] assist the committee in developing model
- 22 protocols for:
- 23 (A) the reporting and investigating of child
- 24 fatalities for law enforcement agencies, child protective
- 25 services, justices of the peace and medical examiners, and other
- 26 professionals involved in the investigations of child deaths;
- 27 (B) the collection of data regarding child

- 1 deaths; and
- 2 (C) the operation of the review teams;
- $\underline{(4)}$ [$\underline{(3)}$] develop and implement procedures necessary
- 4 for the operation of the committee; and
- (5) (4) promote education of the public regarding
- 6 the incidence and causes of child deaths, the public role in
- 7 preventing child deaths, and specific steps the public can
- 8 undertake to prevent child deaths.
- 9 (f) The committee shall issue a report for each preventable
- 10 child death. The report must include findings related to the
- 11 child's death, recommendations on how to prevent similar deaths,
- 12 and details surrounding the department's involvement with the child
- 13 prior to the child's death. Not later than April [December] 1 of
- 14 each year, the committee shall publish a compilation of the reports
- 15 published under this subsection during the year, submit a copy of
- 16 the compilation to the governor, lieutenant governor, speaker of
- 17 the house of representatives, and department, and make the
- 18 compilation available to the public. Not later than October [June]
- 19 1 of each year, the department shall submit a written response on
- 20 the compilation from the previous year to the committee, governor,
- 21 lieutenant governor, and speaker of the house of representatives
- 22 describing which of the committee's recommendations regarding the
- 23 operation of the child protective services system the department
- 24 will implement and the methods of implementation.
- 25 SECTION 3. (a) The child fatality review team committee
- 26 member serving under Subdivision (3), Subsection (a), Section
- 27 264.502, Family Code, immediately before the effective date of this

- 1 Act shall continue to serve as a committee member on and after that
- 2 date until the date a new member is appointed by the Title V
- 3 director of the Department of State Health Services.
- 4 (b) The terms of the members of the child fatality review
- 5 team committee appointed under Subsection (b), Section 264.502,
- 6 Family Code, and serving immediately before the effective date of
- 7 this Act expire February 1, 2008. Not later than February 1, 2008,
- 8 the committee members appointed under Subdivisions (1), (2), and
- 9 (3), Subsection (a), Section 264.502, Family Code, as amended by
- 10 this Act, shall appoint committee members under Subsection (b),
- 11 Section 264.502, Family Code, as amended by this Act.
- 12 (c) The initial terms of the members appointed under
- 13 Subsection (b) of this section shall be determined by drawing lots
- 14 as follows:
- 15 (1) five members shall serve terms expiring February
- 16 1, 2009;
- 17 (2) six members shall serve terms expiring February 1,
- 18 2010; and
- 19 (3) six members shall serve terms expiring February 1,
- 20 2011.
- 21 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
