An original suit requesting only an adoption or for 8 termination of the parent-child relationship joined with a petition 9 for adoption may be filed by: 10 a stepparent of the child; 11 (1)12 (2) an adult who, as the result of a placement for 13 adoption, has had actual possession and control of the child at any 14 time during the 30-day period preceding the filing of the petition; (3) an adult who has had actual possession and control 15 of the child for not less than two months during the three-month 16 period preceding the filing of the petition; [or] 17 18 an adult who has adopted, or is the foster parent (4)of and has petitioned to adopt, a sibling of the child; or 19 (5) another adult whom the court determines to have 20 21 had substantial past contact with the child sufficient to warrant standing to do so. 22 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 23 to a suit affecting the parent-child relationship filed on or after 24

the effective date of this Act. A suit affecting the parent-child relationship filed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the suit was filed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
