3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:								
4	SECTION 1. Subsections (a), (b), (d), and (e), Section								
5	562.109, Occupations Code, are amended to read as follows:								
6	(a) In this section, "automated pharmacy system" means a								
7	mechanical system that:								
8	 dispenses prescription drugs; [and] 								
9	(2) delivers completed prescription drug orders; and								
10	(3) maintains related transaction information.								
11	(b) A Class A or Class C pharmacy may provide pharmacy								
12	services through an automated pharmacy system in a facility that is								
13	not at the same location as the Class A or Class C pharmacy. The								
14	pharmacist in charge of the Class A or Class C pharmacy is								
15	responsible for filling and loading the storage containers for $\underline{\cdot}$								
16	(1) medication stored in bulk at the facility; or								
17	(2) completed prescription drug orders.								
18	(d) An automated pharmacy system may be located only at:								
19	(1) a health care facility regulated by the state; or								
20	(2) in a secure location approved by the board.								
21	(e) The board shall adopt rules regarding the use of an								
22	automated pharmacy system under this section, including:								
23	(1) the types of health care facilities or secure								
24	locations at which an automated pharmacy system may be located[$_{ au}$								

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1	which shall	include a	facility	regulated	under	<u>Chapter</u>	142,	242,	or
2	252, Health	and Safety	<u>/ Code</u>];						

- (2) recordkeeping requirements; [and]
- 4 (3) security requirements; and

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- 5 (4) patient counseling requirements.
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
