1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the use of certain excess contributions to the judicial
1-9 fund that are remitted to certain counties.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 25.00213, Government
1-12 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-13 (b) Money in a contributions fund created under this section
1-14 may be used only for court-related purposes for the support of the
1-15 statutory probate courts in the county, including for the payment
1-16 of the compensation of a statutory probate court associate judge in
1-17 accordance with Section 54.605.

1-18 SECTION 2. Section 54.605, Government Code, is amended by
1-19 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c) to read as
1-20 follows:

1-21 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), the [The]
1-22 compensation of the associate judge shall be paid by the county from
1-23 the county general fund. The compensation must be paid in the same
1-24 manner that the appointing judge's salary is paid.

1-25 (c) On the recommendation of the statutory probate court
1-26 judges in the county and subject to the approval of the county
1-27 commissioners court, the county may pay all or part of the
1-28 compensation of the associate judge from the excess contributions
1-29 remitted to the county under Section 25.00212 and deposited in the
1-30 contributions fund created under Section 25.00213.

1-31 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-32 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-33 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-34 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-35 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
