- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

Trade Practices -- Consumer Protection Act.

- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 17, Business & Commerce
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 17.51 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 17.51. SURVIVAL OF CAUSE OF ACTION. (a) A cause of
- 8 <u>action under this chapter does not abate because of the death of the</u>
- 9 consumer or because of the death of a person liable for the false,
- 10 deceptive, or misleading act or practice that is the basis of the
- 11 cause of action.

- 12 (b) A cause of action under this chapter survives to and in
- 13 favor of the heirs, legal representatives, and estate of the
- 14 consumer. The action survives against the liable person and the
- 15 person's legal representatives.
- (c) The suit may be instituted and prosecuted as if the
- 17 liable person were alive.
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to a cause of action that
- 19 accrues on or after the effective date of this Act. An action that
- 20 accrued before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law
- 21 applicable to the action immediately before the effective date of
- this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
