- 8 department by rule shall develop a program to award grants to public
- 9 elementary and middle schools located in large urban school
- 10 districts for the purpose of establishing:
- 11 (1) demonstration agricultural projects; or
- 12 (2) other projects designed to foster an understanding
- 13 and awareness of agriculture.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 48.002, Agriculture Code, is amended to
- 15 read as follows:
- Sec. 48.002. ELIGIBILITY. Subject to available funds, a
- 17 public elementary or middle school is eligible to receive a grant
- 18 under this chapter if the school:
- 19 (1) is located in a school district with an enrollment
- of at least 49,000 students; and
- 21 (2) submits to the department, at the time and in the
- 22 form required by the department, a proposal for a demonstration
- 23 agricultural project that includes:
- 24 (A) a description of the proposed project;

- 1 (B) a schedule of projected costs for the
- 2 project; and
- 3 (C) a statement of the educational benefits of
- 4 the project, including how the project will improve understanding
- 5 of agriculture.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
