1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to limitations on the compensation of county auditors for
1-9 certain counties.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Subsection (d), Section 152.032, Local
1-12 Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-13 (d) This subsection applies only to ~~[Except as provided by~~
1-14 ~~Subsection (b), in]~~ a county with a population of 500,000 or more,
1-15 excluding a county subject to Subsection (b), or a county with a
1-16 population of more than 1,000 and less than 21,000 that borders the
1-17 Gulf of Mexico. The ~~[the]~~ amount of the compensation and allowances
1-18 of a county auditor in a county subject to this subsection may be
1-19 set in an amount that exceeds the limit established in Subsection
1-20 (a) if the compensation and allowances are approved by the
1-21 commissioners court of the county.

1-22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-26 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
