4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 227.032(b), Transportation Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(b) The department shall [make every reasonable effort to]
8	connect a segment of a state highway that is designated as part of
9	the Trans-Texas Corridor with significant farm-to-market and
10	ranch-to-market roads and major county and city arterials included
11	in the locally adopted long-range transportation plan as determined
12	by the department, taking into consideration:
13	(1) [financial feasibility;
14	[(2)] advice solicited from:
15	(A) county commissioners courts;
16	(B) governing bodies of municipalities; and
17	(C) metropolitan planning organizations;
18	(2) [(3)] circuity of travel for landowners;
19	(3) [(4)] access for emergency vehicles; and
20	(4) [(5)] traffic volume.
21	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
22	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
23	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
