(a) A county may enter into and make payments under an agreement with a 16 private entity or another governmental entity to acquire, 17 construct, maintain, or operate a toll bridge, including an 18 international toll bridge, and a private or governmental entity in 19 this state may enter into an agreement with a county for that 20 21 purpose. 22 (b) In connection with or in support of an agreement entered

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into under Subsection (a), the county may enter into a lease, an

operating agreement, a service agreement, a license agreement, a

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- 1 franchise agreement, or a similar agreement with a private entity
- 2 or another governmental entity.
- 3 (c) This section does not apply to a county with a
- 4 population of more than 675,000.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
