9	SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS
10	Sec. 3861.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
11	(1) "Board" means the district's board of directors.
12	(2) "City" means the City of Arlington.
13	(3) "District" means the Viridian Municipal
14	Management District.
15	(4) "Improvement project" means any program or project
16	authorized by Section 3861.102, inside or outside the district.
17	Sec. 3861.002. CREATION AND NATURE OF DISTRICT. The
18	district is a special district created under Section 59,
19	Article XVI, Texas Constitution.
20	Sec. 3861.003. PURPOSE; LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS. (a) The
21	creation of the district is essential to accomplish the purposes of
22	Sections 52 and 52-a, Article III, and Section 59, Article XVI,
23	Texas Constitution, and other public purposes stated in this

chapter. By creating the district and in authorizing the city and

- 1 other political subdivisions to contract with the district, the
- 2 legislature has established a program to accomplish the public
- 3 purposes set out in Section 52-a, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 4 (b) The creation of the district is necessary to promote,
- 5 develop, encourage, and maintain employment, commerce,
- 6 transportation, housing, tourism, recreation, the arts,
- 7 <u>entertainment</u>, <u>economic development</u>, <u>safety</u>, <u>and the public</u>
- 8 welfare in the district.
- 9 (c) This chapter and the creation of the district may not be
- 10 <u>interpreted to relieve the city or Tarrant County from providing</u>
- 11 the level of services provided as of the effective date of the Act
- 12 enacting this chapter to the area in the district. The district is
- 13 created to supplement and not to supplant the city and county
- 14 services provided in the district.
- 15 Sec. 3861.004. FINDINGS OF BENEFIT AND PUBLIC PURPOSE. (a)
- 16 The district is created to serve a public use and benefit.
- 17 (b) All land and other property included in the district
- 18 will benefit from the improvements and services to be provided by
- 19 the district under powers conferred by Sections 52 and 52-a,
- 20 Article III, and Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and
- 21 other powers granted under this chapter.
- 22 (c) The creation of the district is in the public interest
- 23 <u>and is essential to further the public purposes of:</u>
- 24 (1) developing and diversifying the economy of the
- 25 state;
- 26 (2) eliminating unemployment and underemployment;
- 27 (3) providing quality residential housing; and

1	(4) developing or expanding transportation and
2	<pre>commerce.</pre>
3	(d) The district will:
4	(1) promote the health, safety, and general welfare of
5	residents, employers, potential employees, employees, visitors,
6	and consumers in the district, and of the public;
7	(2) provide needed funding for the district to

11	(3) promote the health, safety, welfare, and enjoyment

15	(e) Pedestrian ways along or across a street, whether at
16	grade or above or below the surface, and street lighting, street
17	landscaping, parking, and street art objects are parts of and
18	necessary components of a street and are considered to be an
19	improvement project that includes a street or road improvement.
20	(f) The district will not act as the agent or
21	instrumentality of any private interest even though the district
22	will benefit many private interests as well as the public.
23	Sec. 3861.005. DISTRICT TERRITORY. (a) The district is
24	composed of the territory described by Section 2 of the Act enacting
25	this chapter, as that territory may have been modified under:
26	(1) Section 3861.107; or

(2) other law.

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- 1 (b) A mistake in the field notes of the district contained
- 2 in Section 2 of the Act enacting this chapter or in copying the
- 3 field notes in the legislative process does not in any way affect:
- 4 (1) the district's organization, existence, or
- 5 validity;
- 6 (2) the district's right to contract, including the
- 7 right to issue any type of bond or other obligation for a purpose
- 8 for which the district is created;
- 9 (3) the district's right to impose or collect an
- 10 assessment, tax, or any other revenue; or
- 11 (4) the legality or operation of the board.
- 12 Sec. 3861.006. ELIGIBILITY FOR INCLUSION IN SPECIAL
- 13 ZONES. (a) All or any part of the area of the district is eligible
- 14 to be included in:
- 15 <u>(1) a tax increment reinvestment zone created by the</u>
- 16 city under Chapter 311, Tax Code;
- 17 (2) a tax abatement reinvestment zone created by the
- 18 city under Chapter 312, Tax Code; or

- 3 <u>SUBCHAPTER B. BOARD OF DIRECTORS</u>
- 4 Sec. 3861.051. GOVERNING BODY; TERMS. The district is
- 5 governed by a board of five directors who serve staggered terms of
- 6 four years, with two or three directors' terms expiring May 31 of
- 7 <u>each even-numbered year.</u>
- 8 Sec. 3861.052. ELECTION DATE. The board shall hold
- 9 elections for directors on the uniform election date in May in
- 10 even-numbered years.
- 11 Sec. 3861.053. ELIGIBILITY. (a) To be qualified to serve
- 12 as a director, a person must own land in the district.
- (b) Section 49.052, Water Code, does not apply to the
- 14 district.
- Sec. 3861.054. VACANCY. (a) The remaining directors shall
- fill a vacancy on the board by appointing a person who meets the
- 17 qualifications prescribed by Section 3861.053.
- 18 (b) If there are fewer than three directors, the governing
- 19 body of the city shall appoint the necessary number of directors to
- 20 fill all board vacancies.
- 21 Sec. 3861.055. DIRECTOR'S OATH OR AFFIRMATION. A
- 22 director's oath or affirmation of office shall be filed with the
- 23 <u>district and the district shall retain the oath or affirmation in</u>
- 24 the district records.
- 25 Sec. 3861.056. OFFICERS. The board shall elect from among
- 26 the directors a chair, a vice chair, and a secretary.
- Sec. 3861.057. COMPENSATION; EXPENSES. (a) The district

- 1 may compensate each director in an amount not to exceed \$50 for each
- 2 board meeting. The total amount of compensation per director per
- 3 year may not exceed \$2,000.
- 4 (b) A director is entitled to reimbursement for necessary
- 5 and reasonable expenses incurred in carrying out the duties and
- 6 <u>responsibilities of a director.</u>

- 22 Sec. 3861.101. GENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES. The district has
- 23 the powers and duties provided by:

- (e) Subject to any agreement between the district and the

- 14 (1) by ordinance, order, or resolution require that
- 15 title to all or any portion of an improvement project vest in the
