No. 932 1 (9) a space for stamping the voter's political party 2 affiliation; a statement that voting with the certificate by a 3 (10)person other than the person in whose name the certificate is issued 4 5 is a felony; 6 (11)a space for the voter's signature; 7 a statement that the voter must sign the (12)8 certificate personally, if able to sign, immediately on receipt; 9 a space for the voter to correct the information (13)on the certificate followed by a signature line; 10 (14) the statement: "If any information on this 11 certificate changes or is incorrect, correct the information in the 12 space provided, sign below, and return this certificate to the 13 14 voter registrar."; [and] 15 (15) the registrar's mailing address and telephone number; and 16 17 (16) a jurisdictional or distinguishing number for any territorial unit in which the voter resides, as determined by the 18 voter registrar, including a congressional district, state 19 senatorial district, state representative district, commissioners 20 21 precinct, justice precinct, city election precinct, or school district election precinct. 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 27

a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
