1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the eligibility of certain Texas Rangers for burial in
1-9 the State Cemetery.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Subsection (d), Section 2165.256, Government
1-12 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-13 (d) Persons eligible for burial in the State Cemetery are:

1-14 (1) a former member of the legislature or a member who
1-15 dies in office;

1-16 (2) a former elective state official or an elective
1-17 state official who dies in office;

1-18 (3) a former state official or a state official who
1-19 dies in office who has been appointed by the governor and confirmed
1-20 by the senate and who served at least 12 years in the office to which
1-21 appointed;

1-22 (4) a person specified by a governor's proclamation,
1-23 subject to review and approval by the committee under Subsection
1-24 (e);

1-25 (5) a person specified by a concurrent resolution
1-26 adopted by the legislature, subject to review and approval by the
1-27 committee under Subsection (e); ~~and~~

1-28 (6) a person specified by order of the committee under
1-29 Subsection (e); and

1-30 (7) an honorably retired officer of the Texas Rangers
1-31 who served at least 12 years as an officer or an officer of the Texas
1-32 Rangers who has either served at least 12 years as a Texas Ranger or
1-33 died in the line of duty.

1-34 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-35 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-36 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-37 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-38 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
