- 2 relating to the waiver of penalty and interest on a taxing unit's
- 3 delinquent payment of its allocation of the budget of an appraisal

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 6.06, Tax Code, is amended by adding
- 7 Subsection (k) to read as follows:
- 8 (k) For good cause shown, the board of directors may waive
- 9 the penalty and interest on a delinquent payment under Subsection
- 10 (e).
- 11 SECTION 2. (a) Section 6.06(k), Tax Code, as added by this
- 12 Act, applies to the waiver of penalty and interest on a payment that
- 13 becomes delinquent under Section 6.06(e), Tax Code, before, on, or
- 14 after the effective date of this Act.
- 15 (b) An appraisal district may refund a payment of penalty
- and interest that was made by a taxing unit under Section 6.06(e),
- 17 Tax Code, before the effective date of this Act if the board of
- 18 directors of the appraisal district waives the penalty and interest
- as provided by Section 6.06(k), Tax Code, as added by this Act.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
