## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the collection of a family protection fee.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 51.961(d), Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- The clerk shall pay a [one-half of the] fee collected 6 under this section to the appropriate officer of the county in which 7 the suit is filed for deposit in the county treasury to the credit 8 of the family protection account. The account may be used by the 9 commissioners court of the county only to fund a service provider 10 located in that county or an adjacent county. The commissioners 11 12 court may provide funding to a nonprofit organization that provides 13 services described by Subsection (e).
- SECTION 2. Section 51.961(g), Government Code, is repealed.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
