AN ACT

2 relating to funding under the instructional facilities allotment

3 for school districts affected by troop reassignments at military

4 installations.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 46.006, Education Code, is amended by

7 adding Subsection (c-2) and amending Subsection (d) to read as

8 follows:

- 9 <u>(c-2)</u> A district's wealth per student is reduced by 25
- 10 percent for purposes of this section if the district demonstrates
- 11 to the commissioner's satisfaction that the district must
- 12 construct, acquire, renovate, or improve one or more instructional
- 13 <u>facilities</u> to serve the children of military personnel transferred
- to a military installation in or near the district under the Defense
- Base Closure and Realignment Act of 1990 (10 U.S.C. Section 2687).
- 16 The reduction is in addition to any reduction under Subsection (a),
- 17 (b), or (c) and is computed before the district's wealth per student
- is reduced under those subsections, if applicable.
- 19 (d) The commissioner shall adjust the rankings after making
- 20 the reductions in wealth per student required by Subsections (a),
- 21 (b), [and] (c), and (c-2).
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
