A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the regulation of the practice of dental hygiene.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 258.001, Occupations Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 258.001. [IMPERMISSIBLE] DELEGATIONS. (a) A dentist
- 7 may not delegate:
- 8 (1) an act to an individual who, by board order, is
- 9 prohibited from performing the act;
- 10 (2) any of the following acts to a person not licensed
- 11 as a dentist or dental hygienist:
- 12 (A) the removal of calculus, deposits, or
- 13 accretions from the natural and restored surfaces of exposed human
- teeth and restorations in the human mouth;
- 15 (B) root planing or the smoothing and polishing
- of roughened root surfaces or exposed human teeth; or
- 17 (C) any other act the delegation of which is
- 18 prohibited by board rule; or
- 19 (3) any of the following acts to a person not licensed
- 20 as a dentist:
- 21 (A) comprehensive examination or diagnosis and
- 22 treatment planning;
- 23 (B) a surgical or cutting procedure on hard or
- 24 soft tissue;

- 1 (C) the prescription of a drug, medication, or
- 2 work authorization;
- 3 (D) the taking of an impression for a final
- 4 restoration, appliance, or prosthesis;
- 5 (E) the making of an intraoral occlusal
- 6 adjustment;
- 7 (F) direct pulp capping, pulpotomy, or any other
- 8 endodontic procedure;
- 9 (G) the final placement and intraoral adjustment
- of a fixed or removable appliance; or
- 11 (H) the placement of any final restoration.
- 12 (b) A dentist may delegate[+ or
- 13 $\left[\frac{4}{4}\right]$ the authority to an individual to administer a
- 14 local anesthetic agent, inhalation sedative agent, parenteral
- 15 sedative agent, or general anesthetic agent if the individual is
- 16 [not] licensed as:
- (1) $[\frac{A}{A}]$ a dentist, with a permit issued by the board
- for the procedure being performed $[\tau]$ if a permit is required;
- 19 $\underline{(2)}$ [(B)] a certified registered nurse anesthetist
- 20 licensed by the Board of Nurse Examiners, only if the delegating
- 21 dentist holds a permit issued by the board for the procedure being
- 22 performed[τ] if a permit is required; [Θr]
- (3) (3) (C) a physician anesthesiologist licensed by
- the Texas <u>Medical</u> [State] Board; or
- 25 (4) a dental hygienist, only if the procedure is the
- 26 <u>administration</u> of a local anesthetic agent under Section
- 27 <u>262.002(a)(6)</u> [of Medical Examiners].

- 1 SECTION 2. Section 262.002, Occupations Code, is amended by
- 2 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to read as
- 3 follows:
- 4 (a) A person practices dental hygiene if the person:
- 5 (1) removes accumulated matter, tartar, deposits,
- 6 accretions, or stains, other than mottled enamel stains, from the
- 7 natural and restored surface of exposed human teeth and
- 8 restorations in the human mouth;
- 9 (2) smoothes roughened root surfaces;
- 10 (3) polishes exposed human teeth, restorations in the
- 11 human mouth, or roughened root surfaces;
- 12 (4) topically applies drugs to the surface tissues of
- 13 the human mouth or the exposed surface of human teeth;
- 14 (5) makes dental x-rays; [and]
- 15 (6) administers intraoral, block, or infiltration
- 16 <u>anesthesia under direct supervision as required by this subtitle</u>
- 17 after completion of a board-approved course; and
- 18 (7) performs any other service, task, or procedure
- 19 prescribed by board rule.
- 20 (c) A dental hygienist may not establish an independent
- 21 practice to provide services authorized by this subtitle.
- 22 SECTION 3. (a) The State Board of Dental Examiners, not
- 23 later than January 1, 2008, shall:
- 24 (1) prescribe by rule the requirements for a course to
- train dental hygienists to administer local anesthetic agents; and
- 26 (2) develop a procedure for the approval of courses
- 27 described by Subdivision (1).

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- 1 (b) A rule adopted under Subsection (a) of this section must
- 2 require that a course is:
- 3 (1) accredited by the Commission on Dental
- 4 Accreditation of the American Dental Association; and
- 5 (2) offered in a classroom setting at an educational
- 6 institution.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
