The amount of the surcharge must be based on sound actuarial principles.

SECTION 2. This Act applies only to an insurance policy delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed on or after January 1, 1-14 1**-**15 1**-**16 1-17 2008. A policy delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed before 1-18 January 1, 2008, is governed by the law as it existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose. 1-19 1-20 1-21 1-22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
