## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 62.051, Labor Code, is amended to read as
5	follows:
6	Sec. 62.051. MINIMUM WAGE. (a) Except as otherwise
7	provided by <u>this section</u> [Section 62.057], an employer shall pay to
8	each employee the federal minimum wage under Section 6, Fair Labor

Standards Act of 1938 (29 U.S.C. Section 206).

- (b) Beginning with the calendar year beginning on January 1, 2008, and each calendar year thereafter, an employer shall pay to an employee not less than the minimum wage established under Subsection (c).
- (c) On October 1, 2007, and each following October 1, the 14 commission shall adjust the minimum wage established under 15 Subsection (b) for inflation. The adjusted minimum wage rate shall 16 be computed to the nearest cent using the consumer price index for 17 18 urban wage earners and clerical workers (CPI-W), as computed by the United States Department of Labor for the preceding 12 months, or an 19 analogous index adopted by the commission by rule. The commission 20 21 by rule shall:
- 22 (1) describe the process used in computing inflation 23 rates and the procedure for determining the level of inflation used 24 in the commission's computations; and

- 2 set the state minimum wage for the subsequent calendar year.
