1-8 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to the regulation of barbers and cosmetologists at mobile
1-11 locations.

1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 1603, Occupations Code, is
1-14 amended by adding Section 1603.206 to read as follows:

1-15 Sec. 1603.206. MOBILE SHOPS. (a) In this section, "mobile
1-16 shop" means a facility that is readily movable and where barbering,
1-17 cosmetology, or both are practiced other than at a fixed location.

1-18 (b) A barbershop, beauty shop, or specialty shop licensed or
1-19 permitted under this chapter, Chapter 1601, or Chapter 1602 may be a
1-20 mobile shop.

1-21 (c) The commission may adopt rules to administer this
1-22 section, including rules providing for:

1-23 (1) the licensing or permitting of a mobile shop;

1-24 (2) the fees for a mobile shop;

1-25 (3) the operation of a mobile shop;

1-26 (4) reporting requirements for a mobile shop; and

1-27 (5) the inspection of a mobile shop.

1-28 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-29 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-30 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-31 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-32 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
