A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to certification of a person as eligible for disabled
3	parking privileges, including an expectant or new mother.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 681.001, Transportation Code, is amended
6	by amending Subdivision (2) and adding Subdivision (3-a) to read as
7	follows:
8	(2) "Disability" means a condition in which a person
9	[has]:
10	(A) <u>has</u> mobility problems that substantially
11	<pre>impair the person's ability to ambulate;</pre>
12	(B) <u>has</u> visual acuity of 20/200 or less in the
13	better eye with correcting lenses; [or]
14	(C) <u>has</u> visual acuity of more than 20/200 but
15	with a limited field of vision in which the widest diameter of the
16	visual field subtends an angle of 20 degrees or less <u>; or</u>
17	(D) is an expectant or new mother.
18	(3-a) "Expectant or new mother" means a person during
19	the period extending from the 30th day before the person is due to
20	give birth to the 90th day after the person is due to give birth.
21	SECTION 2. Section 681.003, Transportation Code, is amended
22	by amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsection (f) to read as
23	follows:
24	(c) Subject to <u>Subsections</u> [Subsection] (e) <u>and (f)</u> , the

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first application must be accompanied by a notarized written 1 2 statement or written prescription of a physician licensed to practice medicine in this state or a state adjacent to this state $[\tau]$ 3 4 or authorized by applicable law to practice medicine in a hospital or other health facility of the Veterans Administration or an 5 advanced practice nurse or physician assistant acting under the 6 7 delegation and supervision of a licensed physician in conformance with Subchapter B, Chapter 157, Occupations Code, certifying and 8 9 providing evidence acceptable to the department that the person 10 making the application or on whose behalf the application is made is 11 legally blind or has a mobility problem that substantially impairs the person's ability to ambulate. The statement or prescription 12 must include a certification of whether the disability is temporary 13 or permanent and information acceptable to the department to 14 15 determine the type of disabled parking placard for which the applicant is eligible. The department shall determine a person's 16 eligibility based on evidence provided 17 by the applicant establishing legal blindness or mobility impairment. 18

(f) An application for a disabled parking placard by an
expectant or new mother must be accompanied by evidence of the date
the person is due to give birth provided by the person's physician.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2007.

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
