A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

relating to prescriptions for certain controlled substances.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Subsections (g) and (h), Section 481.074, Health

1-10 1-11 and Safety Code, are amended to read as follows:
 (g) A person may not dispense a controlled substance in
Schedule III or IV that is a prescription drug under the Federal 1-12 1-13 Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (21 U.S.C. Section 301 et seq.) without a written, oral, or telephonically <u>or electronically</u> communicated prescription of a practitioner defined by Section 481.002(39)(A) <u>or</u> 1-14 1**-**15 1**-**16 1-17 (D), except that the practitioner may dispense the substance 1-18 directly to an ultimate user. A prescription for a controlled substance listed in Schedule III or IV may not be filled or refilled 1-19 1-20 1-21 later than six months after the date on which the prescription is issued and may not be refilled more than five times, unless the 1-22 prescription is renewed by the practitioner. A prescription under this subsection must comply with other applicable state and federal 1-23 1-24 laws.

1-25 A pharmacist may dispense a controlled substance listed (h) 1-26 in Schedule III, IV, or V under <u>a</u> [an original] written, oral, or 1-27 telephonically or electronically communicated prescription issued by a practitioner defined by Section 481.002(39)(C) and only if the 1-28 pharmacist determines that the prescription was issued for a valid 1-29 medical purpose and in the course of professional practice. A prescription issued under this subsection may not be filled or 1-30 1-31 1-32 refilled later than six months after the date the prescription is issued[$_{7}$] and [$_{a}$ prescription authorized to be refilled on the original prescription] may not be refilled more than five times. 1-33 1-34 1-35

unless the prescription is renewed by the practitioner. SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply to 1-36 conduct that occurs on or after the effective date of this Act. 1-37 Conduct that occurs before that date is governed by the law in 1-38 effect when the conduct occurs, and the former law is continued in 1-39 1-40 effect for that purpose. 1-41

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.

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
