- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 552.147, Government Code, is to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 Sec. 552.147. EXCEPTION: SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER OF LIVING
- 8 PERSON. (a) The social security number of a living person is
- 9 excepted from the requirements of Section 552.021.
- 10 (b) A governmental body may redact the social security
- 11 number of a living person from any information the governmental
- 12 body discloses under Section 552.021 without the necessity of
- 13 requesting a decision from the attorney general under Subchapter G.
- 14 (c) A county clerk who in good faith makes available a
- 15 document containing a social security number while carrying out
- 16 their official duties does not commit an offense under Section
- 17 552.352. This subsection expires September 1, 2009.
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
