## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the authority of the Railroad Commission of Texas to
3	regulate warning signs appurtenant to certain pipeline facilities;
4	providing an administrative penalty.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Chapter 91, Natural Resources Code, is amended
7	by adding Subchapter P to read as follows:
8	SUBCHAPTER P. PIPELINE FACILITY WARNING SIGNS
9	Sec. 91.701. COMMISSION JURISDICTION OVER PIPELINE
10	FACILITY WARNING SIGNS. (a) In this section, "hazardous liquid"
11	has the meaning assigned by Section 117.001.
12	(b) The commission has exclusive jurisdiction over warning
13	signs appurtenant to natural gas and hazardous liquid pipelines,
14	gathering lines that are subject to commission jurisdiction over
15	safety standards as provided by Sections 117.011 and 117.012 of
16	this code and Section 121.201, Utilities Code, and distribution
17	facilities.
18	Sec. 91.702. RULES. The commission may adopt all necessary
19	rules governing warning signs described by Section 91.701.
20	Sec. 91.703. ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTY. A violation of a rule
21	adopted under this subchapter is considered to be a violation of a
22	provision of a rule that pertains to safety and is issued under this
23	title for purposes of Section 81.0531.
24	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.

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
