- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Chapter 91, Natural Resources Code, is amended 7 by adding Subchapter P to read as follows:
- 8 SUBCHAPTER P. PIPELINE FACILITY WARNING SIGNS
- 9 <u>Sec. 91.701. COMMISSION JURISDICTION OVER PIPELINE</u>
 10 <u>FACILITY WARNING SIGNS. (a) In this section, "hazardous liquid"</u>
 11 <u>has the meaning assigned by Section 117.001.</u>
- 12 <u>(b) The commission has exclusive jurisdiction over warning</u>
 13 <u>signs appurtenant to natural gas and hazardous liquid pipelines,</u>
 14 gathering lines, and distribution facilities.
- Sec. 91.702. RULES. The commission may adopt all necessary rules governing warning signs described by Section 91.701.
- Sec. 91.703. ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTY. A violation of a rule
 adopted under this section is considered to be a violation of a
 provision of a rule that pertains to safety and is issued under this
 title for purposes of Section 81.0531.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.

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
